In relation to the GSA's support for graduate students' activities, the GSA executives have proposed a funding increase for ratified councils, effective September 2024. This motion necessitates revisions to both policies and bylaws and is scheduled for discussion at the upcoming GSA Annual Meeting.

The proposed rate adjustment involves an increase from \$3.00 to \$6.00, with a maximum limit set at \$1000.00. The calculation is based on the equation outlined in GSA policy section 9.4.3.
